For designer-maker Alice Blogg, being able - quite literally - to get her hands on some British-grown timber when she needs it enables her to produce unique works like these bar pulls and surfaces for the bar/restaurant chain, The Stable. Grown in Britain licence-holder Alice sources some of her wood materials from local

forests close to her workshop. For those with bigger needs, such as builders' merchants and joinery firms, British-grown timber is readily available and can sometimes offer price advantages over imported wood. Some of Britain's biggest forests, and wood product manufacturers like BSW Timber for example, are also Grown in Britain licence-holders, offering solid assurance of their timber's origins.
