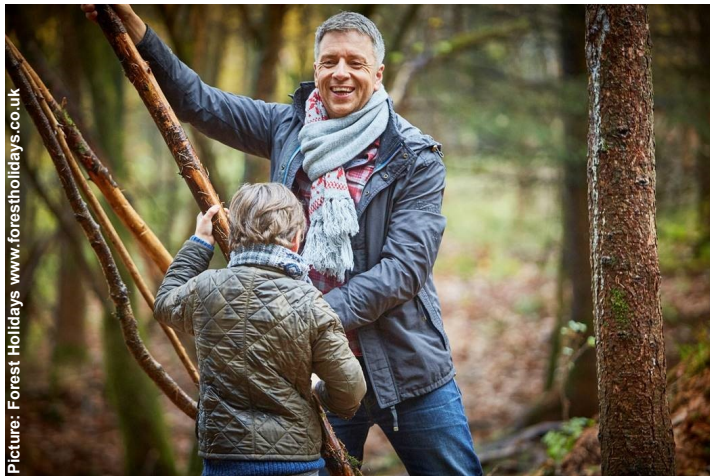


Building a future with wood
